(Deuteronomy 11:18)	<b>17 May Day 02</b> <b>Comoros &amp; Shiromani</b> Pray for women, who wear the Shiromanis (forms a large fabric cross). They are the key to opening this culture to the Gospel. (1 Cor 1:18)	<b>18 May Day 03</b> <b>Peoples of Caucasus</b> Jesus came to set us free. Pray for Caucasians to be "perfected in love" that casts out fear. (1 John 4:18)	<b>19 May Day 04</b> <b>East Arabian Peninsula</b> Pray that just as frankincense found its way to Jesus, so the message of Jesus would find its way to those who grow frankincense. (2 Cor 2:14-16)
	<b>20 May Day 05</b> <b>Dagombas North Ghana</b> Pray for the few Dagomba believers to be a light in their communities as they put their faith in the cross of Christ alone for their protection.	<b>21 May Day 06</b> <b>Pattani Malay</b> Pray that Pattani Malay fishermen will find Jesus and become dedicated fishers for men. (Matthew 4:19)	<b>22 May Day 07</b> <b>Wolof People, West Africa</b> Pray for peace in their land, their relationships and their hearts; for community projects to improve diet and healthcare. (Matt 11:28-29)	<b>23 May Day 08</b> <b>Chiwars of Central Asia</b> Pray for efforts to provide educational and job opportunities in these remote areas, and channels for the Gospel. (Matthew 9:37-38)	<b>24 May Day 09</b> <b>Cairo, Arab Film Industry</b> Pray for peace between Muslim and Christian communities and for Christians to be courageous in loving their Muslim neighbours. (2 Cor 5:18)	<b>25 May Day 10</b> <b>Soninke of West Africa</b> Pray for those working to sow seeds among the Soninke people to be effective. (Matthew 13)
<b>27 May Day 12</b> <b>Religious Turks</b> Pray for Turks from a conservative background to be reached now a colloquial NT is available. (Isaiah 55:11)	<b>28 May Day 13</b> <b>Tunisia</b> Pray that Tunisians would overcome social pressures and that interest in Jesus would become common. (1 John 5:5)	<b>29 May Day 14</b> <b>Chechens in Berlin</b> Pray for Christians in Berlin to proclaim the new life found in Jesus Christ to the Chechens in their city. (1 John 1:2)	<b>30 May Day 15</b> <b>Java Pesisir, Indonesia</b> Pray for Indonesian believers to be bold in witness and for miraculous revelations of Christ among this people. (1 Corinthians 1:7)	<b>31 May Day 16</b> <b>Libyan Muslims</b> Hope is powerful. Pray for hope to be restored so that Libyan's can rise to make their nation a place where the church bells can ring again.	<b>1 June Day 17</b> <b>Albanians in Switzerland</b> Pray for deep friendships between Swiss believers and Albanians that allow for deep faith conversations. (Acts 8:25)	<b>2 June Day 18</b> <b>Shias of Iraq</b> Pray that the local Iraqi Church would continue to be a light in the darkness of the Iraqi desserts. (John 1:5)
<b>3 June Day 19</b> <b>Muslims in Nepal</b> Pray for laws that promote peace and allow freedom for Nepalis to follow the faith of their choosing. (Isaiah 61:1)	<b>4 June Day 20</b> <b>Swahili Bajun of Kenya</b> Pray that the mosques will promote efforts to live peaceably in this diverse nation and provide wise counsel for youth tempted by extremism.	<b>5 June Day 21</b> <b>The Brunei Malay</b> Pray for Brunei Malays who study abroad – they have opportunities to see things in new ways. Christian friends could show them a new Way.	<b>6 June Day 22</b> <b>Domari Gypsy People</b> Pray for more efforts to help the Dom thrive in the places they find themselves living and may the Word be shared with interested seekers.	<b>7 June Day 23</b> <b>Fulbe in Ghana</b> A cultured Fulbe (Fulani) is expected to be patient, wise, modest, respectful and reserved. Pray bridges for the Gospel will be found.	<b>8 June Day 24</b> <b>Chinese Muslims</b> 1 Timothy 2:4-6 describes Christ as our mediator with God. Pray for Chinese Muslims to know Jesus Christ as Mediator.	<b>9 June Day 25</b> <b>Eritrean Prisoners</b> For Eritrean prisoners to be treated humanely and mercifully. For Christians to be reminded to visit those in prison and to bring them comfort.

(Jer 29:11)	<b>11 June Day 27</b> <b>The Berber Fibula</b> Pray Morocco Berbers would come to know Jesus in a relevant, life-changing manner – through pointer in their own culture and context.	<b>12 June Day 28</b> <b>The Sylheti</b> Pray for the discipleship of new believers and the development of new, relevant forms of worship in the Sylheti culture. (John 6:35)	<b>14 June Day 30</b> <b>The Power of Symbols</b> Pray for creative revelation of how symbols can be door-openers for the love of Jesus. (Matthew 13:35)	<b>14 June after Sunset</b> <b>Eid al-Fitr</b> Pray for Muslims as they mark the end of Ramadan.
